When? Friday 22nd – Sunday 24th April 2022

Where? Bibby's Farm Activity Centre, Chorley, PR6 9DL

Who? All sections and every group within Blackpool District

Beavers - As with previous years, Beavers can choose to stay for 1 (Sat-Sun) or 2 nights.

Cost

£40 for Beavers x1 night

£45 for Beavers, Cubs, Scouts, Explorers x2 nights

£25 for Leaders

A deposit of £10 per person is required by 28th February 2022 to secure bookings. The full balance is required by 31st March 2022.

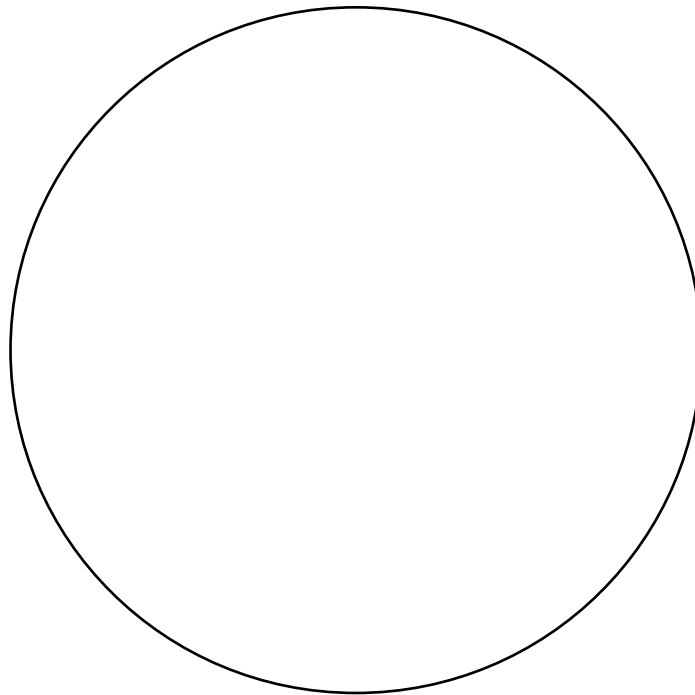
