Standard Kit List



This is a standard kit list for Scout activities and camps. On days out, each Scout should have a day sack with the items listed below. For camps, the list items which should be packed in their main bag.

Scout uniform top and necker should be worn for all journeys / trips unless you are told otherwise. It is important that each Scout packs their own kit so that they know where to find everything instantly.

Most of the equipment listed is widely available, at a range of prices. Advice on suppliers and brands is freely available from the leaders.

Bear in mind that on a camp, any clothing is liable to get muddy and damaged. Everything except the roll mat should be inside the main pack. Do not bring phone / portable games consoles etc, as no responsibility will be accepted for their loss or damage.
