Squirrels all the way through to Network are welcome to join us on either the Monday or the Thursday evening, walking as an entire group or as individual sections. As Brian House at Trinity Hospice is hosting the Elmer Parade, we have joined with them to have this as our theme for this year's walk. Try and visit as many Elmer's as you can and take a picture to show you have been there!

To take part, you need to download the app 'Elmer Blackpool'. We advise groups to arrange a convenient meeting/collection point and time for their group. If you require assistance, please contact the District Cub team.

Risk Assessments will be shared nearer the time. The event should be planned as a meeting away from your HQ, so in touch should be in place and groups are responsible for their own first aid requirements.
